❖ Memorandum of Understanding

With “Groundhog Day” in the rear-view mirror and a predicted early Spring, we can start thinking about outdoor play on the Benchlands Courts again. We fully anticipate the Memorandum of Understanding [MOU] we have with the District of Lake Country to be signed-off in the next few weeks. The 2023 MOU is practically the same as the 2022 version; a few amendments, but nothing that will materially change our court times.
